

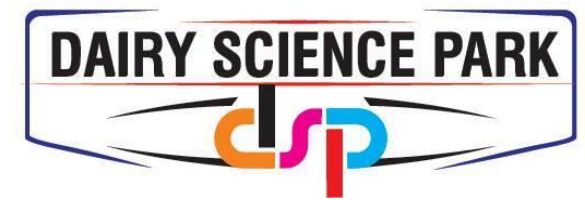

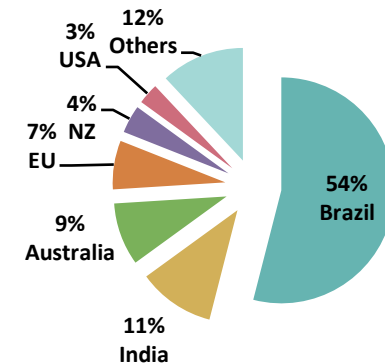

## Partnership packages

- **Registration of potential entrepreneur**
  - Rs. 1000
- **Annual registration of farmers**
  - small size farmers (for up to 2000 broilers, 3000 quails 3000, 30 sheep/goats, or 10 buffaloes/cattle)
    - Rs 3,000
  - medium size farmers (for up to 5000 broilers, 6000 quails, 60 sheep/goats, or 25 buffaloes/cattle)
    - Rs. 6,000
